**October 19 @ noon – Lehigh Parkway—Frisbee Golf for Beginners** led by Mike Solt of the Lehigh Valley Disc Club.

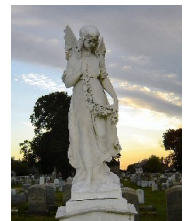
**Art and Funerary Symbolism Tour**
