At 2nd & Hamilton Street students collected litter, raked leaves and planted zebra grass and beautiful hibiscus.

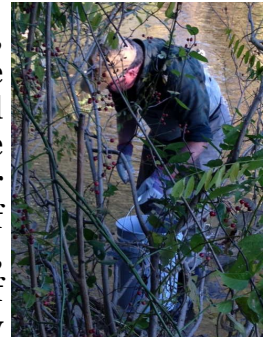


Volunteer Recognition

Little Lehigh Trout Unlimited



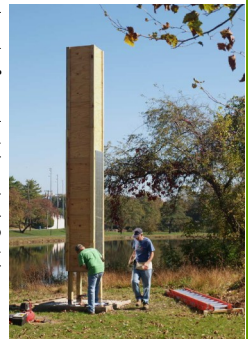
