Basketball Court Improvements at Nine Allentown Parks

Basketball players of all ages are finding resurfaced courts at facilities throughout the City of Allentown. The work included cleaning, patching, repairing and resurfacing two basketball courts at Irving and Jordan parks, one full and one-half basketball court at Trout Creek West and single full basketball courts at Fountain Park and Jordan Meadows.

At Percy Ruhe Park former tennis courts are being resurfaced and relined for use as two new basketball courts. An existing basketball court is also being resurfaced. Player benches, a scorer's table, spectator bleachers, lighting and fencing are included in the improvements.

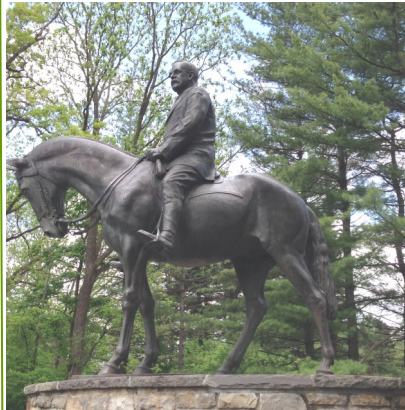

within an urban setting. With 2.5 miles of semi-shaded paved trails visitors can enjoy birdwatching, view public art and a monument to General Harry C. Trexler or simply chat with other visitors.



Recent improvements to the park include repavement of the trails with distinct marking of the bicycle lanes.
