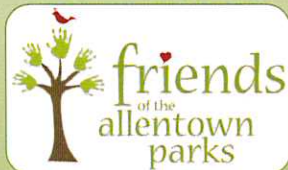

Celebrate the Past

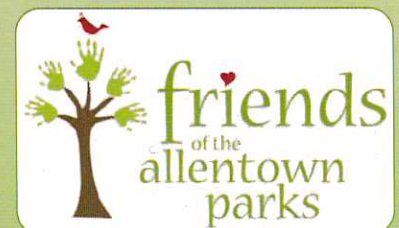

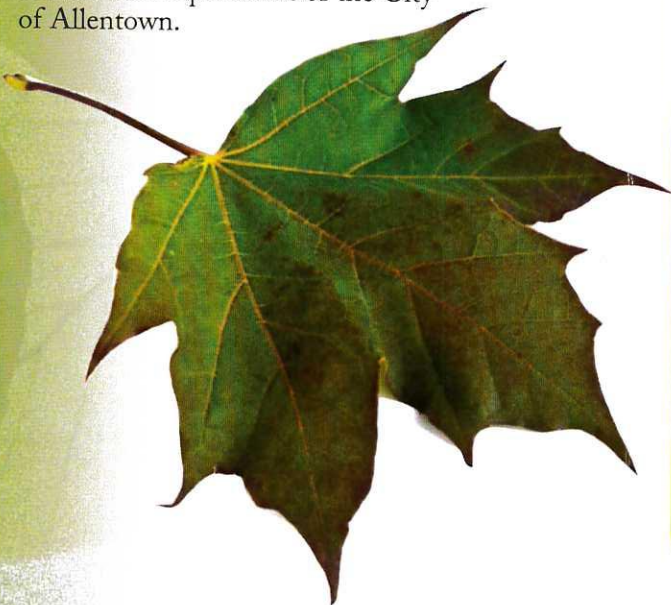
Remembrance Trees

A Living Tribute

Donating a tree to a city park through the Remembrance Tree Program offers participants a unique way to honor a loved one, or celebrate a special occasion while assuring the continuing beauty of Allentown's Parks.

Friends of the Allentown Parks, in cooperation with the Department of Parks and Recreation, will plant a tree in a city park and install a bronze plaque with the name of the donor(s) and the name of the honored person/event.

Varying environmental conditions affecting growth potential of trees within a given park or at given park locations, along with planting programs already in progress, require that Remembrance Tree placements and type of tree be at the discretion of the professional staff of the Parks and Recreation Department of the City of Allentown.



Minimum Donation Per Tree: \$425.00

The tree will be approximately 2.5-3.0 in diameter and 5-6 feet tall.

How The Program Works:

1. Complete the Remembrance Tree order form and return it with a check or money order.

Your contribution to the Remembrance Tree Program is tax deductible to the fullest extent of the law.

Please check with your tax professional for advice pertaining to gifts to the Remembrance Tree Program.

2. Orders received between:

- * January 1 and June 30 will be planted between September 15 and November 15.
- * July 1 and December 31 will be planted between April 15 and June 15.

Note: Planting schedules may be affected by weather and the availability of plant material.

3. After the tree has been planted, the notification person specified on the order form will receive information showing the approximate location of the tree.

4. A Remembrance Tree bronze plaque will be placed near the tree with the specified dedication information. Any other additional decorations will be removed.



5. Remembrance Trees have a one (1) year replacement guarantee due to damage or disease.

What Your Donation Will Cover:

The Department of Parks and Recreation will provide the necessary items to plant and maintain the donated trees as listed below:

- * Pick up from local nursery
- * Add proper soil amendments
- * Staking of trees if needed
- * Water newly planted trees
- * Edge and properly mulch tree wells
- * Perform structure pruning
- * Surveillance and control for insects and disease
- * Bronze Plaque

The City of Allentown will be responsible for the installation and maintenance of your gift.
